Letter of Postgraduate Studentship Award

Dear YEUNG, Tsz Ching,

- 1 I have pleasure in informing you that you will be awarded a Postgraduate Studentship at the Department of Obstetrics & Gynaecology on the following conditions:
 - (A) A postgraduate studentship at a rate of HK\$18,360.00 per month, or as revised by the University from time to time as it considers fit.
 - (B) The award will be tenable subject to your registration (and, if applicable, fulfilment of admission condition with the Graduate School) as a full-time research postgraduate student of the University during the normative period of study, or as conveyed to you when you are approved to change your study mode/programme/degree. If you are admitted to the Ph.D. stream of the "MPhil-Ph.D." Programme, your award period is subject to change in relation to the passing of candidacy requirement. Should you fail to register as a full-time research postgraduate student of the University, or are discontinued from research postgraduate studies at the University for whatever reasons, the award of Postgraduate Studentship will automatically be withdrawn with immediate effect. You will be required to pay tuition fees to the University and pay a continuation fee if you cannot complete the study within the normative study period.
 - (C) The award shall be tenable during the study at the University. Except for periods of absence as provided for in sub-paragraph 1(G) below, you shall not receive any payment under this award for any period of leave of absence unless otherwise approved by the University.
 - (D) As a condition of the award, you shall work towards your research postgraduate degree on a full-time basis and also carry out assignments relating to teaching and research as part of the training for your postgraduate studies, normally for not more than 12 hours per week on average, as prescribed by the Chairperson, Department of Obstetrics & Gynaecology.
 - (E) The award will be paid monthly in arrears with effect from the date you take up the prescribed assignments at the University as certified by the Chairperson of the Department, and shall cease to be payable upon the expiry of the above stipulated award period unless your Postgraduate Studentship is terminated by either party under the provision in sub-paragraph 1(I) below.

- (F) You are required to observe at all times the University's Policy on Research and Policy on Intellectual Property including the procedures and implementation guidelines (accessible at <https://www.orkts.cuhk.edu.hk/policy>), and any other relevant regulations in relation thereto as approved and amended by the University from time to time. This policy applies to the faculty and staff as well as postgraduate students of the University.
 - (G) Within the award period, absence from full-time work towards the postgraduate degree, or from performing the prescribed assignments in the Department requires prior approval from the Chairperson of the Department and the Dean of the Graduate School, and in any case should not exceed 14 working days per year. The award will be correspondingly adjusted for any period of absence exceeding the stipulated rate.
 - (H) During the entire period of study, you shall not undertake any remunerative engagements, full-time or part-time, except with the prior permission of the University.
 - (I) Other than as stipulated in sub-paragraph 1(B) above, prior to the expiry of the award period, the University may terminate, suspend or curtail your Postgraduate Studentship if your study performance is found to be unsatisfactory by your Graduate Division by giving one month notice in writing to you. You may relinquish the Postgraduate Studentship at any time by giving one month notice in writing to the Graduate School or payment equivalent to one month award in lieu of such notice. Should you relinquish the Postgraduate Studentship on your part for whatever reasons prior to the expiry of the award period without giving the stipulated period of notice, you shall be required to pay to the University a sum equivalent to the award which would have been drawn over a period equivalent to the shortfall of the notice given against the stipulated period of notice.
- 2 Please note that the Postgraduate Studentship is a form of financial assistance provided to postgraduate students. Holders of such studentship are not employees of the University.
 - 3 You are requested to observe at all times the guidelines stipulated in the "Code of Conduct for Postgraduate Studentship Holders" (accessible at https://www.gs.cuhk.edu.hk/download/PGS_CodeofCoduct.pdf).

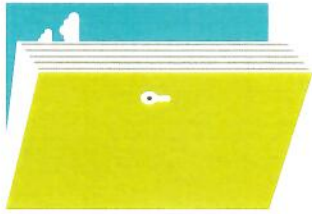
