Prior to your visit

Please send a copy of your flight itinerary with approved academic leave form to Ms. Ching Yee Lai of OAL (chingyee@cuhk.edu.hk) before confirming the booking, regardless of its amount and the method of purchase. The procedures for flight and accommodation reservation and reimbursement of the expenses are set out in Appendix 1 as attached. Here are some key points for your reference:

1. Flight booking can be made either through one of the CUHK's [appointed travel agents](#) (ATAs) or via online portals (e.g., online travel agents or airline portals).

At least one quotation must be obtained from ATAs or online travel/airline portals. Please pass the quotation to OAL for application of the Expenditure Application (EA) and the application of PO.

No price comparison required for direct purchases made with online travel/airline portals.	Min. 2 competitive written quotations are required for air tickets and accommodation. At least one quotation must be obtained from ATAs or online travel/airline portals. Please pass the quotation to OAL for the EA application.

2. Please be reminded to choose the lowest airfare available for the same flight within economy class or instruct the travel agents to expand their search with more airlines for the provision of cheaper tickets.
3. During the visit, you will be covered under the University's Group Travel Insurance (Staff) scheme. You are advised to consider purchasing additional travel insurance for personal activities or periods/activities not covered by the scheme, as well as your own health and hospitalisation insurance.
