### RGC Postdoctoral Fellowship Scheme 2024/25

I am pleased to inform you that the Research Grants Council (RGC) will offer you the RGC Postdoctoral Fellowship to take up a full-time appointment as postdoctoral fellow (PdF) in the Department of Chemical Pathology at The Chinese University of Hong Kong, commencing on or before 31 December 2024. The fellowship provides an annual stipend to cover the basic salary of the full-time PdF appointment as well as a conference and research-related travel allowance for a period of 36 months.

The rate for the first annual stipend in this exercise is HK\$420,090 (inclusive of the annual conference and research-related travel allowance at HK\$13,350). Subject to the confirmation by The Chinese University of Hong Kong on your satisfactory performance during the fellowship period, the rate for the annual stipend (as well as the rate for the inclusive travel allowance) will be adjusted annually with reference to the Composite Consumer Price Index (CCPI) announced by the HKSAR Government.

This fellowship is offered to you under the “PDFS Terms and Conditions”<sup>†</sup> as attached at **Annex 1**. Your acceptance of our offer thereof shall be interpreted as your undertaking to accept the “PDFS Terms and Conditions”. This offer is also subject to your fulfilment of the requirements, terms and conditions as laid down by The Chinese University of Hong Kong for employment with a full-time PdF appointment. You are obliged to fully comply

with the rules, regulations and requirements, including but not limited to employment, as prescribed by The Chinese University of Hong Kong. Failure to meet any of the requirements contained in this letter and the attached "PDFS Terms and Conditions" may result in termination of the fellowship.



Kindly note that The Chinese University of Hong Kong will approach you later regarding the offer of a full-time PdF appointment and the employment terms and conditions as well as related arrangements. The Chinese University of Hong Kong is required to advise the RGC (via the UGC Secretariat) in due course your scheduled fellowship commencement date, and will be acting on behalf of the RGC to disburse the fellowship annual stipend (inclusive of the conference and research-related travel allowance) during your fellowship period in accordance with its prevailing procedural arrangements.
