Myers Professor of the Department of Electrical Engineering, Bioengineering and Medical Engineering, I write this letter to confirm and verify that from January 6 of 2017 to present, Dr. Chan was offered and accepted a position as Postdoctoral Scholar in the Division of Engineering & Applied Science at the California Institute of Technology.

The position of Postdoctoral Scholar offered to Dr. Chan is a research position.
