I am pleased to inform you that the above application for the Innovation and Technology Fund (ITF) Research Talent Hub for Technology Companies Conducting Research and Development Activities in Hong Kong (RTH-TC) has been **approved on condition** that the research talent's graduation certificate will need to be presented to the Innovation and Technology Commission (ITC) before reimbursement of RTH funding. A maximum monthly provision of HK\$32,000 and HK\$1,500 (i.e. the monthly salary allowance and employer's MPF contribution respectively) for the research talent, SHAIK-ABDULLAH-NAWABJAN, from 20/04/2023 to 19/04/2025, will be provided. The maximum funding amount granted for this engagement is **HK\$804,100.**

2. Your company should ensure that **R&D duties** are assigned to the research talent, with an appropriate level of workload which warrants a **full-time engagement**.
3. As part of the funding conditions, you are required to submit the following documents:-
 - (a) **progress report(s)** duly signed by both the Project Coordinator and the research talent on a half-yearly basis together with the **relevant supporting documents** (including employment contract, salary pay slip(s) signed by the research talent, MPF record, etc.) throughout the RTH-TC period;
 - (b) **evaluation reports** by both the Project Coordinator and the research talent within one month from the completion or termination of the engagement.
4. Please note that conditions of funding as set out in the **RTH-TC Application Guide** forms part of the funding agreement. You are reminded to observe the requirement stated in the Application Guide regarding the engagement. In particular, please note that according to the Guide, you should submit a change request for any **subsequent change to the details of the engagement (e.g. change in engagement duration, project coordinator, salary adjustment, allowance adjustment etc.)** to the Innovation and Technology Commission (ITC) for **prior approval**. In case of **any change in the engagement commencement date, resignation** of the research talent or **termination** of the engagement during the engagement period, your

company is required to notify the ITC **immediately**.

5. The monthly salary allowance (plus MPF contribution) will be provided to your company **on a reimbursement basis** after acceptance of the progress report(s) by the ITC. The reporting schedule is as follows:

With effect from 1 April 2023, the maximum level of monthly allowance for salary under RTH-TC for research talent with bachelor's, master's and doctoral degree has been increased to HK\$20,000, HK\$23,000 and HK\$35,000 respectively. An additional monthly living allowance of HK\$10,000 will also be provided to research talents participating in the RTH-TC with doctoral degrees. To effect the aforementioned new rate(s) of monthly allowance for the research talent of the subject engagement, please submit change requests electronically through the Innovation and Technology Commission Funding Administrative System (ITCFAS) (<https://itcfas.itf.gov.hk>) together with relevant supporting documents evidencing your research talent's salary and/or the HK\$10,000 living allowance (in full) provided/to be provided (e.g. salary adjustment notification to the research talent, updated employment contract, etc.).

7. Applicant companies should note that any misrepresentation or omission of information in the applications or progress/evaluation reports may lead to rejection of the applications and/or full recovery of the monthly allowances already granted by the ITC, and possible court proceedings. The ITC reserves at all times the absolute right to review all applications and adjust the ITF allowances approved as necessary. In the event that there is an overpayment due to error in calculation or assessment, applicant companies are required to refund the amount overpaid within one month upon notification.

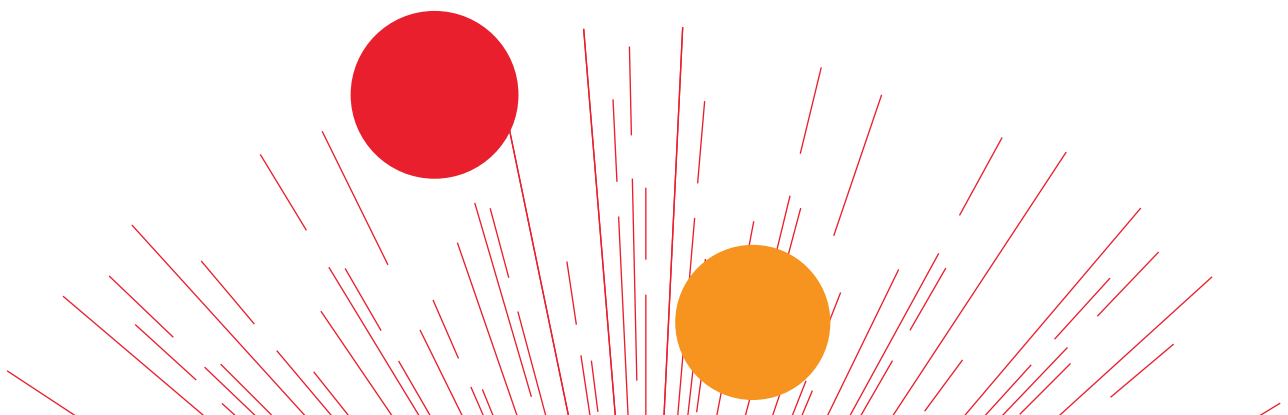


