### Value of scholarship:

#### Fees

The Trust will pay 100% of the University Composition Fee for the tenure of your course at Cambridge.

The University Composition Fee will be paid directly to your College in instalments, in the Lent Term (February) for each year of your award, as agreed with the University and Colleges.

#### Maintenance allowance (living costs)

The Trust will pay you an annual maintenance allowance for the duration of your course. In the academic year 2021/22, your maintenance allowance will be **£15,609** for twelve months. If your award is longer than twelve months, maintenance in subsequent years will be paid at the rate set for that year.

If your course begins in a term other than Michaelmas in October (e.g. Lent Term in January or Easter Term in April), the rate will be paid pro-rata.

The maintenance allowance will be paid directly to you, as follows:

- If your course is nine or ten months in duration, your maintenance will be paid in three equal instalments at the beginning of each quarter (i.e. in October, January and April).
- If your course is eleven or twelve months in duration, your maintenance will be paid in four equal instalments at the beginning of each quarter (i.e. in October, January, April and July).

The maintenance allowance is sufficient to meet the financial guarantee required for your admission to be confirmed.

Please note that the amount is intended to support a single person and the Trust does not pay supplements for maintenance or for dependants.

Maintenance is paid by bank transfer. Please note we can only pay into a UK bank account. If you do not yet have a UK bank account, you must open one as soon as you are able.

In order to receive your payment by bank transfer we will need you to complete the BACS (Bank Automated Clearing System) payment form (which will be sent with this letter) and provide proof that the UK bank account is in your name. Therefore, please complete and return the BACS form as soon as possible and provide a copy of your UK bank statement that clearly shows:

- Bank name and address
- Your name and address
- Account number
- Sort code

We do not need to see any transactional details so you are advised to cover these. We will destroy the bank statement once we have confirmed the information.

Maintenance can only be paid once we have confirmation from your College that you have started your course.

### **Immigration Health Surcharge**

The award will include an allowance of **£1,645** to meet the cost of your Immigration Health Surcharge. You will receive this allowance with your first maintenance payment.

Please note that the award does not pay for your visa or for private healthcare.
