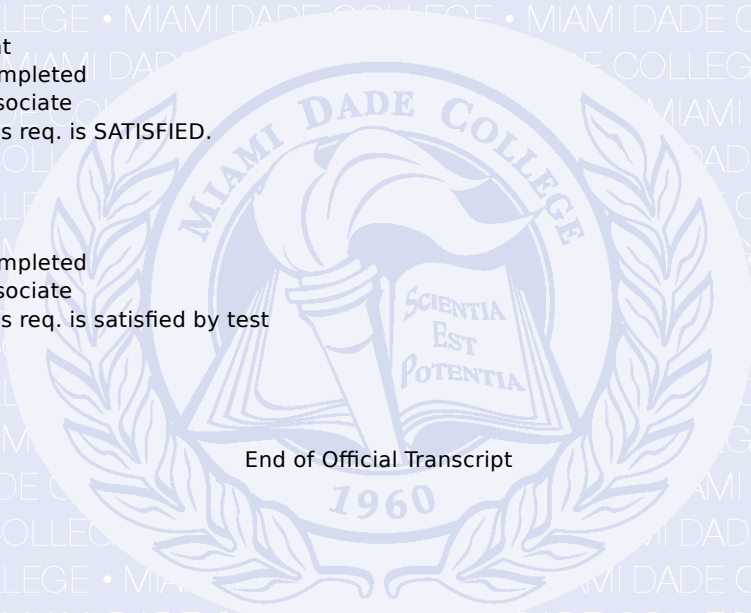

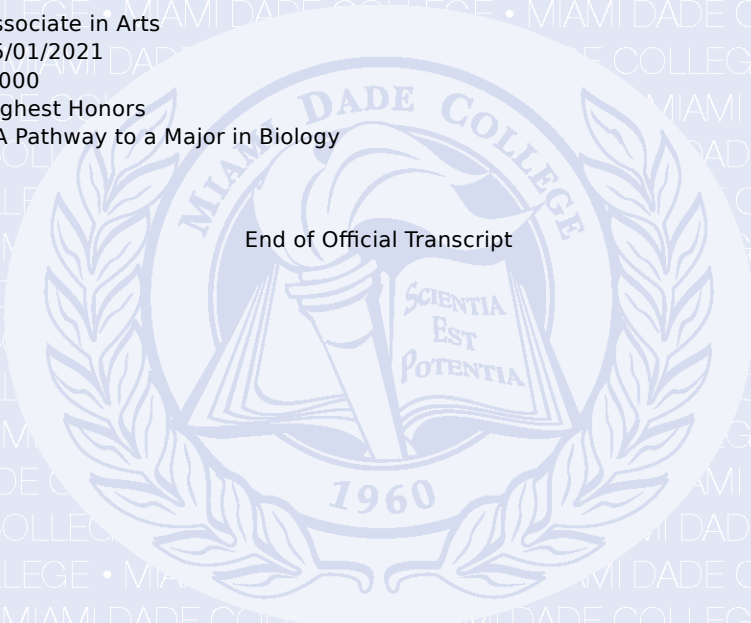

INCOMPLETE GRADES: Students have until the allotted time to finish the coursework; otherwise a failing grade will be assigned.

WITHDRAWAL POLICY: Students may withdraw from (drop) courses on the web or in person within the withdrawal period indicated on their class schedule and on the official College calendar.

ACADEMIC AMNESTY: Students with credits that are ten years or older may petition to have those credits and the entire prior record excluded from their cumulative grade point average calculation. This is a one-time privilege. Students may not request specific credits to be excluded.

HONORS CURRICULUM: Miami Dade College offers an honors curriculum with both individual honors courses and honors college courses in selected academic areas, as well as The Honors College program. Honors courses and honors college courses are individually identified on the transcript.

MDC UNIT OF CREDIT: Miami Dade College awards semester credits and vocational credits. One semester credit is normally given for a class that meets 50 minutes per week for approximately 16 weeks. Semester credits are also given on shorter terms, but the classes meet longer and more frequently each week. One vocational (Career and Technical Education) credit is normally given for 30 contact hours of classroom participation.

GRADE POINT AVERAGE (GPA): Grade Point Average is accumulated separately for college credit, vocational credit (Career and Technical Education) and Educator Preparation Institute courses. Prior to Fall Term 1978-79, MDC college credit courses numbered 900 or higher, or lower than 100, were not used in determining the cumulative GPA. Effective Fall Term 1978-79, college credit courses numbered 9000 or higher, or lower than 1000, are not used in determining the cumulative GPA, except if a student earns a "U" grade in a Developmental Education course at Miami Dade College.

DEGREES GRANTED:

BACHELOR OF APPLIED SCIENCE (BAS), BACHELOR OF SCIENCE (BS), and BACHELOR OF SCIENCE IN NURSING (BSN): Four-year baccalaureate degrees are awarded to students in selected programs.

ASSOCIATE IN ARTS (AA): The AA is a two-year degree designed to transfer to upper division study (baccalaureate degree) at a Florida public university or Florida state college. AA degree graduates from Florida state colleges meet the general education requirements. See also State of Florida Articulation Agreement herein.

ASSOCIATE IN SCIENCE (AS): The AS is a two-year degree awarded to students who have successfully completed a technical or occupational program designed for immediate employment preparation. Chapter 6A-10.024 of the Florida Administrative Code provides a Career Ladder Articulation Agreement that integrates specific AS degree programs with specific baccalaureate degree programs.

ASSOCIATE OF APPLIED SCIENCE (AAS): The AAS is a two-year degree awarded to students who complete a program of specialized study for immediate entry into business and industry. It is no longer awarded as of December 2020.

ASSOCIATE IN GENERAL STUDIES: This is a two-year degree awarded to students who may or may not have chosen to follow a prescribed program of study, which allowed students to select a variety of academic and occupational courses. It is no longer awarded as of August 1989.

GRADUATION WITH HONORS: Degree program graduates are eligible for the following honor designations:

CERTIFICATES GRANTED:

CERTIFICATION OF COMPLETION: (Designated as Diploma of Graduation prior to Summer Term 1968). This was a certificate awarded to students who completed 60 semester credits, but either had not satisfied the requirements of a specific program or had not earned a satisfactory grade point average. This certificate was discontinued after August 1981.

COLLEGE CREDIT CERTIFICATE: This is a certificate awarded to students completing a short, prescribed program designed for students to enter or progress in the job market.

ADVANCED TECHNICAL CERTIFICATE: This is a certificate awarded to students who have already earned an AS degree in a related field and wish to upgrade their skills.

CAREER AND TECHNICAL EDUCATION: This is a certificate awarded for completion of a Career and Technical Education program of study that prepares students to enter a specific career or vocation.

APPLIED TECHNOLOGY DIPLOMA: This is a diploma awarded to students who complete a series of courses that are an integral part of either a related AS degree or a Career and Technical Education program that will result in credit toward an AS degree.

EDUCATOR PREPARATION INSTITUTE: This is a post-baccalaureate certificate approved by the Florida Department of Education as an intensive, competency-based accelerated certification program designed for career changers who wish to become certified teachers.
