Poster presentation guidelines

As JITMM 2022 is a hybrid conference, all poster presenters, onsite and virtual, are requested to pre-record their presentation (3-5 minutes), so that virtual attendees will also be able to view their research.

Physical poster: the rectangular poster-board surface area is **90 cm wide x 180 cm high**. An appropriate poster size, therefore, is **85 cm wide x 150 cm high**.

E-poster: **A4 size** (297 mm Width x 210 mm Height) in **Landscape orientation** and in PDF format.

Pre-record a 3-5 minute presentation of your poster. You may prepare 2-5 slides relevant to your poster. Please refer to the attached recording guidelines using Zoom. You may also use the attached JITMM image background and PowerPoint slide template. Send the e-poster and a link to download your recorded presentation to jitmm@mahidol.ac.th by 15 November 2022.
